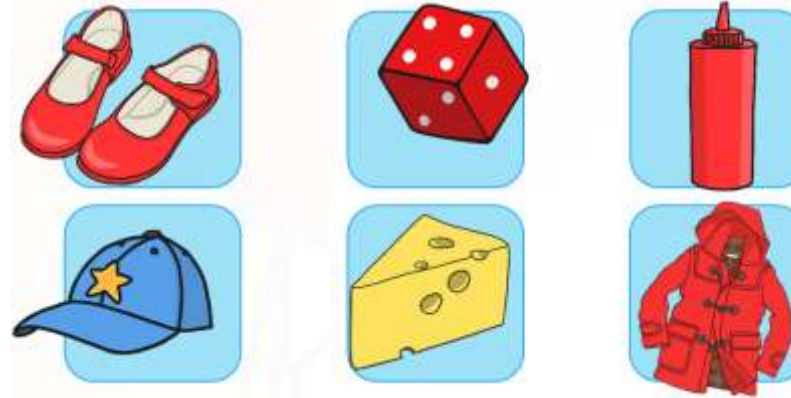


Can you name everyday materials and describe their properties?
