
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Dear Parents,

We are delighted to announce the details of our new reading rewards system, which will hopefully encourage your children to read more at home and involve you more in their reading journey from Year 1 to Year 6.

They have been sent home with a brand-new Home Reading Record book today which needs to be completed whenever they read at home. Each entry should include the date, title of the book, pages read and a brief comment. Each entry needs to be signed by an adult and the reading record handed in on a Monday morning.



On Monday mornings, the number of reads for your child will be counted and recorded. Your child will earn Reading Points which will be awarded as below

1 point for 3 or 4 reads in 7 days

2 points for 5 or 6 reads in 7 days

3 points for 7 reads in 7 days

The reads must be **daily** - they can't read 7 times in one day and earn 3 points!

The reading record must be given in on a Monday. Points can be earned during the holidays (except for summer).

When they have accrued enough points, they will earn one of our brand-new Reading Award badges which they can proudly wear to school each day.

The Bronze award will be given at 75 points

The Silver award will be given at 150 points

The Gold award will be given at 250 points

The Ruby award will be given at 400 points

The Diamond award will be given at 600 points

At the end of the year your child's points will be passed onto the next teacher so they can continue working for their awards during their time at Hillside.



We are so excited to see your children reading more and hope that it will encourage them to try to read for at least 20 minutes each day.
